The DS-160 must be completed online, accessible at <https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/>. After completing the new DS-160, the applicant will electronically submit the application and will be provided with a confirmation page that includes only limited biographical information and a bar code. This CONFIRMATION PAGE must be sent along with the other requested documentation.
3. One 2X2 passport-style photograph on plain white background taken within the last six months, one for each applicant regardless of age or gender. See: http://travel.state.gov/visa/immigrants/types/types_1320.html.
4. Updated DS-156E signed by the owner, CEO, corporate secretary, or other responsible senior employee legally empowered to act in the firm's name, but not the individual applicant;
5. Supporting evidence as to the individual's qualifications as an Investor, Managerial/Executive, or Specialized/Essential employee;
6. Copy of the individual applicant's passport, all pages;
7. US \$390 MRV fee in certified check or international money order payable to the U.S. Consulate General Toronto for each individual applicant.

Upon the expiration date noted above, the company will again be required to submit the full package of documents for re-registration. If there are significant changes in the company, such as a change of ownership or the relocation of its headquarters to a different state, please advise this office and submit appropriate verification.
